## Golden Day Trips – Gravity and Xscape/Centre:MK

I am extremely pleased to inform you that your child has met our behaviour and attendance expectations since 28<sup>th</sup> October and is, therefore, able to go on the trip to Gravity and Xscape/Centre:MK in Milton Keynes on **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2021**.

Your child needs to be at school for **8.35am** and then go straight to the **Theatre Hall** to register and assemble with the other students and staff, before being escorted to the coaches. The students will leave school by 9.15am and travel to Gravity in the Xscape Centre.

Your child should wear sensible clothes and footwear and only have a small bag with them. Your child can either buy lunch when in Xscape/Centre:MK or take a packed lunch that they can eat in the venue. Please can I remind you that **no nuts** or **products containing nuts** should be included as some of our students do have nut allergies. Students will be allowed to go around Xscape/Centre:MK in groups of 3-4 minimum. Staff members will be positioned throughout both venues should your child have an issue, or need additional support.

We have a two-hour session booked with Gravity between 11.00am-1.00pm. Students will have a little time before they enter Gravity in the Xscape Centre, and some additional time afterwards before the coaches depart. Providing they remain in groups they will also be able to visit the Centre:MK at this time. The coaches will depart from the Xscape Centre:MK at 3.10pm and we envisage students returning to school for **approximately 4.00pm**.

I would also like to make you aware that due to the fact that we have a range of different trips taking place on Tuesday, the road outside of the school is likely to become very congested. We would therefore suggest that, should you need to collect your child, you **park on Engayne Avenue** to help ease congestion and also allow for **safe and easy bus access**.
