Year 11 Roadmap

We thought that it would be beneficial to offer you a clear pathway of what you can expect to be studying in each of your subjects on your return to school in September, for the coming term at least. Some departments have gone beyond the Autumn term in this booklet, but we will be issuing Roadmaps every term. At present, we do not have the specific examination board requirements for how grades will be calculated, or any changes to the content of the examinations in 2022. Therefore, we are making some assumptions which we are hoping will be in line with the examination board requirements, once these are known. If we do need to make any changes following further guidance from the examination boards in September, we will ensure that you are informed as soon as possible.

Each subject area has identified what you will be taught over this time period, and what assessments will take place to help assess your progress and any intervention needed. You can expect to have a baseline assessment during the first two weeks. All assessments will be undertaken in the classroom, other than mock examinations, if the lifting of restrictions allow. If additional time or support is required, due to you having special examination arrangements, these will be provided and be in place, for any in-class assessments that you do, along with any mock examinations.

We are aware that this is a difficult and anxious time, but we want to try and give you a clear indication of what the next term will look like, to help you plan and identify what you are studying and when.

We know that each and every one of you has the potential to reach your target grades. Even if you have struggled with remote learning this is an opportunity now, as it is not too late, to work towards making sure that you reach the highest grade possible, and to show us that you are doing your best. We want to be able to celebrate with you in August 2022 when you receive your qualifications, and for you to then go on to the next stage of your learning journey.

We look forward to you returning to school on **Tuesday 7th September**.
